NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the General Election to be held on November 3, 2026, in the City of Eagle River, Wisconsin, the following referendum question will be submitted to the electors of the City pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 9.20.

PROPOSED CHARTER ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TERM LIMITS FOR THE OFFICES OF MAYOR AND ALDERPERSON

Referendum Question

Shall the City of Eagle River adopt a charter ordinance creating Section 2-105 of the Eagle River Municipal Code to establish term limits for the offices of Mayor and Alderperson by:

1. Limiting service as Mayor or Alderperson to four consecutive two-year terms;
2. Requiring a six-year period before a person who has served four consecutive terms may again serve in the same office;
3. Prohibiting a person who has served four consecutive terms as Mayor from immediately serving as an Alderperson, and prohibiting a person who has served four consecutive terms as an Alderperson from immediately serving as Mayor; and
4. Counting terms served both before and after enactment of the ordinance when applying these term limits
