Motion by Schaffer, 2nd by Forer to approve the agenda in any order. Carried all.

Motion Schaffer, 2nd by Forer to approve the minutes of the 3-6-25-2025 meeting. Carried, with Horant abstaining.

- a) <u>Oath of Office:</u> Oath of Office was recited by Brown, Schaffer, Hletko, Adamovich, Horant, and Forer. Grassl completed Oath of Office with Clerk at City Hall.
- b) <u>Public hearing: An Ordinance Amending the City of Eagle River Sign Ordinance to Exclude Public Art Murals from Permitting Fee Requirements and Allow Limited Sponsor Recognition:</u> Ginner presented proposed Ordinance reporting this was brought to her by Margelofsky for beautification around city with murals. The proposed ordinance came about with a new mural being done in 2025 over the Champion Sign on the wall behind the Square. Incredible Bank requested their name as a sponsor be added to the new mural. This sponsorship addition to the mural created the problem that it is creating a sign for the bank and current sign regulations would apply. The proposed ordinance would allow for a "Sponsored by: only the name", exempt from sign permit as it would be classified as a mural not a sign, provision that City Administrator would be authorized to issue a no cost permit to for approval. Public Hearing was opened at 5:10PM with no one in attendance and Ginner reporting no comments were received. Public Hearing was closed at 5:10PM. Discussion by members of the Commission. Schaffer requested confirmation that building with Champion sign is not in historical district. *Motion by Horant, 2nd by Adamovich to recommend City Council adoption of Ordinance amending the City of Eagle River existing sign ordinance to exclude public art murals from permitting fee requirements and allowing for limited sponsor recognition. Carried on a roll call vote, all.*

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 106 – ZONING, ARTICLE VI – DISTRICTS, DIVISION 6 – DOWNTOWN COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, SECTION 106-443 USES PERMITTED BY CONDITIONAL GRANT, AND DIVISION 7 – HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, SECTION 106-473 USES PERMITTED BY CONDITIONAL GRANT OF THE CITY OF EAGLE RIVER MUNICIPAL CODE

The Common Council of the City of Eagle River, Vilas County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Sections 106-443 and 106-473 of the City of Eagle River Zoning Code to allow Laundromats and Dry Cleaners as uses permitted by conditional grant in both the Downtown Commercial District and the Highway Commercial District. This change will enable consideration of these uses through the conditional grant process to ensure compatibility with surrounding uses and community standards.

SECTION 2. Amendment to Section 106-443 – Downtown Commercial District.

Section 106-443 (Uses Permitted by Conditional Grant) of Division 6 (Downtown Commercial District) is hereby amended to add the following:

(11) Laundromats and Dry Cleaners

SECTION 3. Amendment to Section 106-473 – Highway Commercial District.

Section 106-473 (Uses Permitted by Conditional Grant) of Division 7 (Highway Commercial District) is hereby amended to add the following:

(11) Laundromats and Dry Cleaners

SECTION 4. Severability.

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION 5. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
